UNIFORM REGULATIONS

1. It is expected that all items be bought from the College Uniform Shop to ensure uniformity of colours and styles.
2. If, for an unavoidable reason, a student is unable to meet the uniform requirements on a particular day then parents are requested to forward a note with explanation to the appropriate Head of Primary or Head of Students (for Secondary) who will issue an exemption for a maximum of 2 days.
3. Where a student's dress does not meet the College requirements and no explanation has been forthcoming, parents will be notified. Where ongoing non-compliance occurs, disciplinary action will be taken in line with College Policy.
4. In cases where students for medical reasons need an exemption or modification to a component of the Uniform and Appearance Code, a medical certificate is required and a formal notification of the exemption will be sent to parents and staff.
5. Students' appearance must be neat and tidy at all times. This includes wearing a well maintained and clean uniform with shirts tucked into trousers, shorts, slacks or skirts, as appropriate.
6. Girls' hemlines must be worn just above the knee (four fingers).
7. Hair is to be clean and neatly groomed. Fringes are to be above eyebrows. No partial tiebacks are acceptable and hair if longer than the tip of the collar must be held back completely (e.g. plain clips, pony tails, plaits, pig tails). Accessories are to be of College colours: solid red, navy blue or white only – not patterned.
8. Shaven heads, shaved areas, braided locks (including Bali braids) or hairs standing-up inappropriately from the head (e.g. Mohawk or 'horns') are not acceptable styles. Only the normal ranges of naturally occurring hair shades are acceptable in Secondary. In Primary there will be no artificial change of hair colour. Final interpretation of acceptability of hairstyles rests with the Deputy Principal (Students) K-12.
9. Senior boys will be clean-shaven.

10. The College has a 'no hat – no play in the sun' policy. As such, it is compulsory for all students to wear the College hat whilst outdoors under College care, including recess and lunch breaks.
11. A watch plus two other items of plain jewellery are permitted in Secondary, e.g. one pair of earrings or sleepers, plus a necklace, bracelet or ring. Necklaces or bracelets must consist of simple silver or gold, not leather or other 'chunky' forms. Earrings must be sleepers or studs, one in each lobe only. Jewellery in other body piercing is not permitted.
12. Jewellery in Primary is restricted to a watch and one pair of sleeper/stud earrings.
13. Black leather or synthetic College style lace-up shoes must be worn. They must be clean and polished. Sneakers, boots, backless, platform, high-heeled and pump shoes are not to be worn. Sandals must be navy blue College type (Primary only).
14. Summer uniform is to be worn during Terms 1 and 4, winter uniform during Terms 2 and 3. Teachers will advise of any variations due to excursions or un-seasonal weather. The winter uniform is to be worn on formal occasions.
15. The Secondary tracksuit top may only be worn for sport, physical education or sporting excursions as designated by the sports staff.
16. Teachers will specify the uniform appropriate for individual excursions.
17. Make-up and nail polish are not to be worn with the College uniform. Clear or neutral UV protection (sunscreen) may be worn.
18. For health and safety, scarves are not to be worn in classrooms.
19. Belts must be plain, leather/vinyl black with a plain buckle.
20. Primary students (Kindy to Year 6) may wear the College jumper over summer or winter uniform.
21. As from 2009 the College blazer will become a compulsory item for Year 10, 11 and 12 students. Students in Years 7, 8, and 9, are also encouraged to wear the College blazer as from 2009.

As from 2010 the College blazer will be a compulsory item for ALL secondary students ie Year 7 to 12. The College blazer must be worn to all formal College events.
22. The College blazer is to be worn as the first item of warmth for both the summer and winter uniform. If extra warmth is required, a College jumper may be worn under the College blazer.

The Kingsway Christian College School Bag will also become a compulsory item as from 2009 for all students (Kindergarten to Year 12)

Students in Kindy and Pre Primary are required to wear the College Sports Uniform as detailed under the SPORT section for Primary Boys and Primary Girls below.

SECONDARY UNIFORMS (Year 7 – 12)

From 2009 the College bag is a compulsory item for all students K – 12

From 2010 Students in Secondary will have the College Blazer added as a compulsory item.
