Section 1. School Identification

Kingsway Christian College, governed by the Kingsway Christian Education Association (KCEA) Inc.

Section 2. Mission, Vision and Values

Kingsway Christian College is a co-educational non-denominational Christian day school with approx. 1400 students enrolled in K-12. The College has a friendly professional team of staff, modern facilities and attractive employment conditions.

The College has in place organisational Mission, Vision and Values which reflect the strategic directions of the College governing body, the Kingsway Christian Education Association (KCEA) Inc.

At Kingsway, we support and nurture our students so they can excel in their education, strive for excellence and develop their individual character. Kingsway has a state of the art music and theatre facility, including a 900 seat auditorium, and we are striving to deliver a music education program in keeping with best practice.

The College is fully committed to the protection of children, and to this end has in place policies and procedures for the recruitment and screening of staff, suitable to work with children and young people, who meet the selection criteria. The College is free of alcohol, illegal drugs and tobacco.

Section 3. The Position

Position – Trumpet Tutor

A Trumpet Tutor is required for approximately one day's worth of teaching starting Term 1 2026 with the opportunity for that to continue to grow in time. This is a mixture of individual lessons and also small groups. The ages range from Year 5 up to Year 11. Lessons are 40 minutes long.

Section 5. Reporting

Overall responsibility for the College lies with the Principal supported by the Senior Leadership Team comprising the positions of Director of Corporate Services, Dean of Secondary, Dean of Primary, Dean of Christian Formation, Director of IT and the Director of Community Engagement.

Peripatetic Instrumental Music Tutors report to the Head of Music who has oversight of the College music programme.

Section 6. Responsibilities and Duties

Overview

At Kingsway Christian College, Music is an important part of College life with instrumental programs and many ensembles.

Role

The Peripatetic Instrumental Music Tutor conducts private instrumental music tuition lessons for students in the College Music programme.

Christian Values

The position requires you to be committed to the Christian vision of the College by:

- Celebrating and enjoying being a Christian and being part of a Christian community;
- Modelling Christian behaviour, practices and beliefs;
- > Building cooperative and supportive relationships with staff, students and parents;
- > Striving for excellence in performance and participation;
- Acting in the best interests of the College, the Association and its ethos.

Specific Duties

Under the direction of the Head of Music, the duties of a Peripatetic Instrumental Music Tutor include the following:

Educational

- Plan and deliver weekly instrumental lessons appropriate to each student's age and ability.
- Organise the lesson schedule and communicate this with parents and students through the school teaching and learning platform.
- Establish with each student, a Practice Diary in which guidance is given weekly and communication with parents is maintained.
- Support performance opportunities as they present themselves, such as preparing students for school performances.

Administrative

- Tutors are required to organise their lesson schedule and communicate this with parents and students through the school teaching and learning platform.
- Maintain attendance records as required.
- Where any student from Years 1-5 fails to attend a lesson, visit the class to establish the reason, and escort the child to the lesson if they have forgotten.
- Where a student attendance record appears unsatisfactory, inform the Head of Music to determine appropriate action.
- Notify the Head of Music at the earliest possible time when you will be absent from lessons because of sickness or other unexpected circumstances.
- Provide semester reports as requested by the Head of Music by the given deadline.

Professional

- Conduct yourself in a professional manner always acting in the best interests of the Student and the College.
- Participate in peripatetic music meetings as organised by the Head of Music, for which remuneration will be paid.

Support College events as required where the Music Department is actively involved.

Additional information

- The Yr 5 Band program uses a Band Method book to guide the lessons in the early stages and all the students meet weekly for an ensemble rehearsal as well as their group lesson on their instrument.
- There is potential for the successful applicant to also be involved in one of our many ensembles depending on your time availability, as a way of building more time into your KCC schedule. Remuneration will be paid for directing and administering ensembles.

Section 7. Selection Criteria

Pre-requisites

- 1. Satisfactory Department of Education Criminal History Clearance no more than 3 months old.
- 2. Working With Children Check clearance.
- 3. Written reference from Church Pastor/Minister.
- 4. Legally entitled to work in Australia with proof of Australian Birth, Citizenship or residency visa details.
- 5. Personal faith and commitment to the Lord Jesus Christ including regular church attendance and a lifestyle consistent with the expectations of Christian faith.
- 6. Supportive of the aims, principles and tenets of Kingsway Christian Education Association Inc. at Kingsway Christian College.

Essential

- 1. Possess appropriate tertiary qualifications and show a commitment to ongoing professional development.
- 2. Have a passion and energy for developing young musicians through a broad approach to music encompassing all styles, delivering individual and group lessons as part of the school music program.
- 3. Familiarity with a variety of teaching and learning strategies to meet students' needs.
- 4. Have the ability to communicate effectively with people and to be a "team player". Ideally you should have a demonstrated ability to work within a school or team.
- 5. High level interpersonal skills with the ability to establish and develop positive relationships with students, parents and colleagues.
- 6. Strong organisational skills, including punctuality.
- 7. Show empathy with, and an understanding of young people.
- 8. Good computer literacy skills.
